§ 263. Falsely assuming to be officer
Cite as: 21 CNCA § 263

Every person who shall falsely assume or pretend to be any tribal officer, or who shall knowingly take upon himself to act as such or to require any person to act as such, or assist him in any matter pertaining to such office, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one (1) year nor less than three (3) months, and by fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) nor less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).
