§ 589. False reporting of crime

It shall be unlawful to willfully, knowingly and without probable cause make a false report to any person of any crime or circumstances indicating the possibility of crime having been committed, including the unlawful taking of personal property, which report causes or encourages the exercise of police action or investigation, and any person violating the provisions hereof shall be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of not more than Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000), or by imprisonment for not more than three (3) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
