

**Cherokee Nation Code Annotated**  
**Title 10A: Cherokee Nation Juvenile Code**  
**Article 2**  
**Chapter 8: Miscellaneous Offenses**  
**§ 2-8-224. Penalties**  
Cite as: 10A CNCA § 2-8-224

Any person violating the provisions of this title, unless otherwise prescribed, may be punished by:

1. a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per offense;
2. up to eighty (80) hours of community service;
3. a referral for a proposed probation plan which shall be adopted through disposition;
4. attendance and successful completion of an educational program or a delinquency prevention and diversion program. The court shall have the discretion to order the parent or legal guardian of the juvenile to attend and successfully complete the educational program; and/or
5. imprisonment for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days or by payment of a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by both such fine and imprisonment.
