Chapter 39: Cherokee Nation Obscenity and Child Pornography Act

§ 1024.2. Purchase, procurement or possession of child pornography—Penalty

Cite as: 21 CNCA § 1024.2

It shall be unlawful for any person to buy, procure or possess child pornography in violation of 21 CNCA §§ 1024.1 through 1024.4. Such person shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a term of imprisonment not to exceed three (3) years or by a fine in an amount not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000), or by both such imprisonment and fine, provided that such sentence shall include a term of imprisonment. Any person convicted of a violation of this section shall be required to register as a sex offender pursuant to 57 CNCA § 1 et seq. The jury, if any, shall be advised that the mandatory sex offender registration is a civil remedy that shall be in addition to the actual imprisonment.
