Chapter 45: Rape, Abduction, Carnal Abuse of Children and Seduction

§ 1116. Punishment for rape in second degree

Cite as: 21 CNCA § 1116

Rape in the second degree is a felony punishable by a term of imprisonment not to exceed three (3) years or by imposition of a fine in an amount not the exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000), or by both such fine an imprisonment. Any person convicted of a subsequent violation of rape in the second degree shall be guilty of a felony punishable as provided in this subsection and shall not be eligible for probation, suspended or deferred sentence.
