Chapter 53: Manufacturing, Selling and Wearing Weapons

§ 1272.3. Unlawful discharge of stun gun or deleterious agent—Penalties

Cite as: 21 CNCA § 1272.3

It is unlawful for any person to knowingly discharge, or cause to be discharged, any electrical stun gun, tear gas weapon, mace, tear gas, pepper mace or any similar deleterious agent against another person knowing the other person to be a peace officer, corrections officer, probation or parole officer, firefighter, or an emergency medical technician or paramedic who is acting in the course of official duty. Any person violating the provisions of this section, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for a term of not exceeding three (3) years, or by a fine of not more than Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000), or by both such fine and imprisonment.
