§ 1289.17A. Felony discharging firearms
Cite as: 21 CNCA § 1289.17A

It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully or intentionally discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon at or into any dwelling, or at or into any building used for public or business purposes. Any violation of the provisions of this section shall be a felony punishable by imprisonment for a term of not more than three (3) years. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any law enforcement officer in the performance of any lawful duty.
