Chapter 1: Cherokee Heritage Center Act of 2020–2025 Amendments

§ 1004. Establishment of Successor Cherokee National Historical Society

Cite as: 32 CNCA § 1004

The Principal Chief is authorized to file articles of incorporation to establish the Cherokee National Historical Society (hereinafter "CNHS (2020)"), under the laws of the Cherokee Nation, upon the earliest of:

- A. Receiving written notice that Cherokee National Historical Society, Inc, established in 1963 under the laws of the State of Oklahoma (hereafter "CNHS (1963)"), has dissolved; or
- B. Confirming that CNHS (1963) has transferred ownership of all land, buildings, equipment, assets, collections and historic documents to the Cherokee Nation; or
- C. 30 days of enactment of this Act.
