Chapter 6: Cherokee Nation Tribal Youth Council Act
§ 603. Tribal Youth Council
Cite as: 70 CNCA § 603

A. A Cherokee Nation Tribal Youth Council is hereby created to develop leadership in Cherokee youth within the fourteen counties of the Cherokee Nation Reservation and At Large. This Cherokee Nation Tribal Youth Council shall be funded and administered pursuant to the Youth Leadership Program as previously established under the Indian Education Act.

B. The members of the Cherokee Nation Tribal Youth Council shall be provided a monthly stipend to be paid after the first meeting of each month. The monthly stipend for Tribal Youth Council members shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
